In the Government Order first read above, the minimum rates of wages for the employment in Agarbathi Manufactory were revised under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948).

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, a Preliminary Notification was issued in order to revise further the minimum rates of wages for the employment in Agarbathi Manufactory.
- 3. The Commissioner of Labour in his letter third read above, has stated that no objection and suggestion were received from the persons likely to be affected by such revision and has requested the Government to confirm the above said Preliminary Notification.
- 4. The Government have now decided to confirm the orders issued in the Preliminary Notification.
- 5. The appended Notification will, accordingly, be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> both in English and Tamil. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079 is requested to publish the Notification and send five copies of the Gazette to the Government and to the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 0006 for reference and record. The Director, Tamil Development and Information (Translation) Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 is requested to send the Tamil translation of the Notification to the Works Manager, Governmer Central Press, Chennai-600 079.

APPENDIX. NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 nd sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No.II(2)/LE/725/2012, published at pages 575 to 576 of Part II-Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 31st October 2012, the Governor of Tamil Nadu after consultation with the Advisory Board hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of employees in the employment in Agarbathi Manufactory in the State of Tamil Nadu specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof.

2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its publication in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>.

Note.- The Classification of Zones are as follows :-

Zone – A All Corporations

Zone – B All Municipalities

Zone - C All Townships, Town Panchayats and Contonments.

Zone – D Other areas not covered in Zones A, B and C.

Explanations.-

- 1. <u>Dearness Allowance</u> (For Home workers on par with Industrial workers).-Dearness allowance shall be calculated at the rate of Rs.34.55 for rolling of 1000 bathis. However, the maximum dearness allowance should not exceed Rs.103.65 even though the rolling of bathis exceeds 3000 in a day.
- 2. Dearness Allowance (for industrial workers).-
 - (i) The Dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2010. (i.e. 161 points with base 2001=100) and for every rise of one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs.28.55 (Rupees Twenty eight and fifty five paise only) per point per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.
 - (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on 1st April on the basis of the average of the Consumer Price Index for the preceding 12 months i.e. from January to December.
 - (iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> based on the average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the previous year.

- (iv) To arrive at daily rates of wages the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.
- (v) Where the nature of the work is the same no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.
- (vi) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.
