



## ABSTRACT

Unorganised Workers Welfare Boards – Integration of web portal for the Unorganised Workers with the e-Sevai portal to enable services to the citizens through Common Service Centres - Charges fixed for the services offered to the workers – Orders – Issued.

2. From the Commissioner of Labour letter No.W1/42021/2015, dated 23.11.2020 and 23.02.2021.

### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board has been permitted to create an integrated Application Software for all Unorganised Workers Welfare Boards, functioning under the administrative control of Labour Department through TNeGA, at a cost of Rs.1,04,72,000/- for Software application development, operation / maintenance / training and networking by utilizing Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Fund.

2. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner of Labour has stated that the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board has requested to provide concurrence for the integration of integrated application software with e-Sevai application, wherein the workers can register themselves through Common Service Centres (CSC) across the State. It was also informed that the workers / applicants shall pay applicable service charges to the operator at Common Service Centre for availing

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the service. Further, the technical bid document emphasized that the Web portal should be integrated with the existing e-Sevai to enable the services to the citizens through Common Service Centres. However, transaction charges of Common Service Centres and / or charges to be paid by the citizen were not mentioned.

3. The Commissioner of Labour has also stated that the Commissionerate of e-Governance has agreed that the charges fixed for the services of unorganized worker welfare boards as Rs.60/- for each transaction through e-Sevai application. He has requested to Government to issue suitable orders for integration of Integrated Application Software with e-Sevai application, wherein the workers can register themselves through Common Service Centres across the State and to fix the quantum of charges.

4. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Labour and order that the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board web portal shall be integrated with e-Sevai to enable its services to the citizens through Common Service Centres (CSC). Further, the Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board shall be permitted to give concurrence to the Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency regarding charges of CSC and to fix it at Rs.60/- for each transaction by an unorganised worker for the usage of e-sevai application in its centres.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.13053/Fin.(L&E)/2021, Dated:15.06.2021.
