ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Labour has sent a proposal for establishing a new welfare board for the unorganised salt pan workers under sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Tamil Nadu Manual Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Work) Act, 1982 (Tamil Nadu Act 33 of 1982).

2. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Labour and hereby order that a new welfare board shall be established for the unorganised workers, working in salt pans namely "Tamil Nadu Salt pan Workers' Welfare Board" under section 6(1) of the Tamil Nadu Manual Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Work) Act, 1982 (Tamil Nadu Act 33 of 1982).

3. Tamil Nadu Salt pan Workers' Welfare Board is constituted with the following stipulations:-

(i) The above Board will become functional initially with 9,809 salt pan workers as members who are already registered members of the Tamil Nadu Manual Workers Social Security and Welfare Board.

(ii) The unorganised workers in the salt manufacturing sector will be encouraged to enroll themselves in the Board as members which will be free of cost as in the case with all other welfare boards.

(iii) Welfare schemes / measures / assistances that are being extended to the members of all other unorganised workers welfare boards will also be extended to the members of the "Tamil Nadu Salt pan Workers' Welfare Board".

4. Orders regarding administration, nomination of members to the above Board will be issued separately.

5. The appended Notification will be published in the Extraordinary issue of Tamil Nadu Government Gazette both in English and Tamil. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 001 is requested to send 30 copies of the Gazette to the Government and 30 copies to the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 006.

6. The Director, Tamil Development and Information (Translation) Department will furnish the Tamil version of the Notification to the Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 001 for publication in the Gazette.

7. This order does not require the concurrence of Finance Department vide G.O.(Ms.) No.334, Finance (BG-I) Department, dated 22.10.2022.
