#### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, a Committee was appointed under the Chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner of Labour, Tiruchirappalli for fixation of minimum rates of wages for the employment in Distillery Industry. The said Committee conducted various meetings with the employers and employees and submitted a report to the Commissioner of Labour.

- 2) The Commissioner of Labour in his letter second read above, has sent the report of the said committee along with his recommendations to the Government for the fixation of minimum rates of wages for the employment in Distillery Industry.
- 3) The Government have carefully examined the report of the said committee and the recommendations of the Commissioner of Labour. The Government accepts the recommendations of the Commissioner of Labour and accordingly decided to fix the minimum rates of wages for the employment in Distillery Industry.
- 4) The appended Notification will, accordingly, be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu</u> <u>Government Gazette</u> both in English and Tamil. # APPENDIX. NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after considering the advice of the Committee appointed under clause (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the said Act, hereby fixes the minimum rates of basic wages payable to the classes of employees in the employment in Distillery Industry in the State of Tamil Nadu specified in column (2) of the Schedule below as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof:-

2. This Notification shall come into force on and from the date of its publication in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>.

Dearness Allowance: In addition to minimum rates of basic wages Explanations: 1. fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as Indicated below:-

- The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer (i) Price Index for the year 2010, that is 161 points (with base year 2001 = 100) and for every raise of one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs. 48.65/- ( Rupees Forty Eight and Sixty Five paise only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.
- The Dearness Allowance shall be calculated on the first April of every (ii) year on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceding twelve months, namely from January to December.
- The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of (iii) this notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, based on the average of Chennai City Consumer Price Index Number for the previous vear.
- Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages (2)shall be made between men and women employees.
- To arrive at daily wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26. (3)
- Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, (4)the same shall be continued to be paid.
