**ORDER:**

In the Government Order second read above Government have approved an Action Plan for eradication of the use of Child Labour in the State. The Action Plan proposes observances of one day every year as “Anti Child Labour Day” to focus Public attention on the subject. The Commissioner of Labour has reported that the International Labour Organisation(ILO) observed 12<sup>th</sup> June every year as “Anti Child Labour Day”. He has proposed that it would be desirable to follow the ILO and observe 12<sup>th</sup> June of every year as “Anti Child Labour Day”.

3. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of Commissioner of Labour and direct that the 12<sup>th</sup> June of every year be observed as “anti Child Labour Day”.
