The following Notification will be published in the Tamilnadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

Whereas the Motor Transport Service, has been declared to be a public utility service for the purpose of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947(Central Act XIV of 1947), for a period of six months up to and inclusive of the 25.03.2002 in the Labour and Employment Department Notification No.II(2)/LE/764/2001, dated the 26th September 2001 published at page 396 of Part II-Section 2 of the Tamilnadu Government Gazette, dated the 26th September 2001.

And whereas, the Governor of Tamilnadu is of opinion that public interest requires the extension of the said period for a further period of six months;

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-clause (vi) of clause (n) of section 2 read with the proviso there to of the said Act, the Governor of Tamilnadu hereby extends the period specified above for a further period of six months commencing from the date of publication of the Notification in the Tamilnadu Government Gazette.
