**ORDER :**

The following Notification will be published in the Tamilnadu Government Gazette.

**NOTIFICATION**

Whereas the Motor Transport Service has been declared to be a public utility service for the purpose of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act XIV of 1947), for a period of six months up to and inclusive of the 7.5.2001 in the Labour and Employment Department Notification No. II (2)/LE/1144/2000, dated the 8.11.2000 published at page 550 pf Part-II Section 2 of the Tamilnadu Government Gazette, dated the 8<sup>th</sup> November 2000.

And whereas, the Governor of Tamilnadu is of opinion that public interest requires the extension of the said period for a further period of six months;

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-clause (vi) of clause (n) of Section 2 read with the proviso thereto of the said Act, the Governor of Tamilnadu hereby extends the period specified above for a further period of six months commencing from the date of publication of the Notification.
