ORDER

In the Government Order first read above, the minimum rates of wages for the employment in agriculture and works ancillary to agriculture were revised under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948).

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, a Preliminary Notification was issued in order to revise further the minimum rates of wages for the said employment in agriculture and works ancillary to agriculture.
- 3. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Land Reforms, in his letter third read above, has stated that no objections and suggestions were received from the persons likely to be affected by such revision and has requested the Government to confirm the above said Preliminary Notification.
- 4. The Government have now decided to confirm the orders issued in the Preliminary Notification.
- 5. The appended Notification will, accordingly, be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> both in English and Tamil. The Secretary to Government, Tamil Development and Information Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 is

requested to send the Tamil translation of the Notification to the Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079 is requested to publish the Notification and send five copies of the Gazette to the Government and to the Commissioner of Land Reforms and the Commissioner of Labour for reference and record.

<u>APPENDIX</u>

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No.II(2)/LE/510 (c) /2009, published on pages 1 and 2 of Part II – Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, Extraordinary, dated the 1st October 2009, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the Advisory Board, hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of employees in the employment in agriculture and works ancillary to agriculture as specified in Part-II of the schedule to the said Act, in the State of Tamil Nadu, specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof, the draft of the same having been previously published as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section of the said Act.

2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its publication in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>.

THE SCHEDULE

Serial Number.	Classes of employees	Minimum rates of wages per day
(1)	(2)	(3)
(1)	Employees engaged in ploughing with bullocks and ploughs supplied by him.	Rs.325/-
(2)	Employees engaged in ploughing with bullocks and ploughs not supplied by him.	Rs.146/-
(3)	Employees engaged in harvest of paddy reaping, carrying to threshing floor, threshing, winnowing, measuring and bagging.	Rs.146/- per day, who do the work for six hours or in kind to the extent of 1/8 th of the gross yield of produce whichever is higher, per day.
(4)	Employees engaged in harvest of crops other than paddy.	Rs.146/- per day, who do the work for six hours.
(5)	Employees engaged in sowing, plucking of seedling, re-planting of seedling or weeding operations.	Rs.146/- per day, who do the work for six hours.

(6)	Employees engaged in other agricultural Rs.	146/- per day, who do
	operations, namely trimming bunds and fields, the	work for six hours.
	bee-keeping, poultry farming, dairy farming	
	and climbing trees.	

- Explanations:- (1) The above revised minimum rates of wages shall also apply to the agricultural labourers employed in Colleges and Research Station under the Tamil Nadu Agricultural University and Agricultural Farms maintained by the Agriculture, Horticulture and other Government Departments.
- (2) Where there is no difference in the daily hours of work and where the same work or work of a similar nature is performed, no distinction in the payment of wages should be made between men and women employees as per the Equal Remuneration Act, 1976 (Central Act 25 of 1976.
- (3) For the purpose of this Notification, minimum rates of wages specified above shall be all inclusive of rate allowing for the basic rate, cost of living allowance and the cash value of concession, if any, but if does not include the cost of food, if any, supplied to the employees and hence the cost of food shall not be deducted from the minimum rates of wages paid to the employees.
