ORDER:

In the Government order first read above the Government have reconstituted the Plantations Labour Housing Advisory Board, the terms of which has expired on 13-10-2001.

2) The Commissioner of Labour was therefore requested to send proposals for reconstitution of the said Board.

3) Based on the proposals sent by the Commissioner of Labour, the Government have decided to reconstitute the Plantations Labour Housing Advisory Board. The appended Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette. The Tamil Development and Culture (Translations) Department shall send the Tamil Version of the Notification to the Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai for publications in the Gazette.

4) The Plantations Labour Housing Advisory Board will be treated as a First Class Committee for the purpose of Travelling Allowances admissible to its non-official members. The tenure of the non-official members of the said Board will be for 3 years from the date of publication of the Notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette and the members shall continue in office until the appointment of the successor is notified.

5) The Government authorise the Joint Commissioner of Labour (Administration), Chennai who is the Chief Inspector of Plantations to counter-sign the Travelling Allowance bills of the non-official members of the said Board.

6) The term of the office of members etc., shall be governed in accordance with the provisions of rules 55 to 66 of the Tamil Nadu Plantations Labour Rules, 1955.

7) The expenditure should be debited to 2230. Labour and Employment - 01. Labour - 001. Direction and Administration - I.Non-plan - AA. Head Quarters staff - Commissioner of Labour - Travel Expenses - voted".

8) This order does not require the concurrence of Finance Department vide G.O.Ms.No.1177, Finance (All-I) Department, dated 19-09-1973.
