ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have re-constituted the Plantations Labour Advisory Committee for the period of three years from 01-08-1998. The term of Office had expired on 31-07-2001.

2) The Commissioner of Labour was therefore requested to send proposals for re-constitution of the said committee.

4) The Plantations Labour Advisory Committee will be treated as a first class committee for the purpose of travelling allowance admissible to the non-official members. The tenure of the non-official members of the Plantations Labour Advisory Committee shall be for 3 (three) years and the members may be allowed to continue in office until the appointment of the successors are notified.

5) The Government authorise the Joint Commissioner of Labour (Administration), Chennai-6 to countersign the Travelling Allowance Bills of the non-official members of the Committee.

6) The expenditure should be debited to "2230. Labour and Employment - 01. Labour - 001. Directions and Administration - I.Non-Plan - AA. Head Quarters Staff - Commissioner of Labour - 04. Travel Expenses - 01. Tour Travelling Allowance (D.P.Code No. 2230 01 001 AA 0416).
