

Trade Unions – Non – registration / delays in registration of Trade Unions – Prescribing 90 days time limit for disposal of applications for registration of Trade Union – Orders – Issued.

1). From the Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, letter No.S-13012/3/2011-IR (PL), dated:31.01.2013.

2). From the Commissioner of Labour letter No.S3/9072/2013, dated: 06.09.2013 and 14.11.2014.

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have requested to make necessary provisions for disposal of applications for registration of Trade Unions, in the respective State Regulations either by incorporating appropriate amendment in the State Regulation or by issuing an Executive order to State Registrars.

- 2. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner of Labour has sent a proposal for issue of executive orders prescribing 90 days time limit for disposal of applications for registration of Trade Unions.
- 3. The Government, after careful consideration, accepts the above proposal of Commissioner of Labour and hereby orders that the Registrars of Trade Unions should dispose the application for registration of Trade Union, within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of such application if he/she is satisfied that the Trade Union has complied with all the requirements for registration.
- 4. The Commissioner of Labour is directed to send necessary proposal along with draft notification to amend the Tamil Nadu Regulations under the Trade Unions Act, 1926 (Central Act XVI of 1926) to incorporate necessary provisions prescribing time limit for disposal of applications for registration of Trade Unions.
