Applications are invited for the Good Industrial Relations Award 2021 to 2024 to be presented by the Labour Department, Government of Tamil Nadu.

Information from the Labour Commissioner, Mr. S.A. Raman, I.A.S

The Tamil Nadu Government has been implementing the "Industrial Relations Award Scheme" since 1975, for improving industrial relations between industrial establishments and employees, by awarding prizes to the industries and the trade unions that excel in "maintaining industrial relations". Under this award scheme, the first and second prize winners will be awarded a shield, prize money and certificates of merit. A tripartite committee headed by a retired judge will select the winners.

Applications are invited from the industries and the trade unions for the Good Industrial Relations Award. Applications for this award can be downloaded from the website of the Labour Department (<http://www.labour.tn.gov.in/GIRA>) or can be obtained directly from the office of the Assistant Commissioner of Labour (Conciliation) in the respective districts and the office of the Commissioner of Labour, 6th Avenue, Anna Nagar, Chennai -40.

Along with each application, an entry fee of Rs. 100/- in case of a trade union and Rs. 250/- in case of an employer should be sent to the name of "The Secretary, (Special Joint Commissioner of Labour, Office of the Commissioner of Labour) Good Industrial Relations Award Committee, Anna Nagar, Chennai -40" under the Head of Account ("0230-00 Labour and Employment 800 Other Receipts -227 Non Taxation fees -99 Others - AG Receipt of Labour Department (DP Code No. 0230 00 800 AG 22799)") at the Treasury Branch of the State Bank of India along with the original payment slip (challan) of the amount paid.
